A free 20-week training program, designed for parents, caregivers, and community members who want to make a difference on behalf of children

PLTI is open to anyone who cares about the well-being of children. Over the course of 20 weeks, you’ll learn to become an effective advocate for children and a change agent for your community. You’ll also complete a community project of your design, to put your new skills into action.

PLTI teaches you how to identify problems affecting children – in schools, communities, and local and state government – and work towards solutions.

By exploring your own passions, strengths and ideas, you’ll develop leadership, interpersonal, and communication skills. By learning about government and the media, you’ll understand how to engage with the political system to get your voice heard.

The children of PLTI participants ages 3-12 may participate in the Children’s Leadership Training Institute (CLTI), where they will learn leadership skills in a fun, literacy-based way, and engage in a group community project. Apply today!
